All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products & services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

<p>ATTENDED FUNERAL This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the person at the same time as they attended their burial or cremation. Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements. Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (within 15 miles of the funeral directors premises) into the funeral director's care Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased will be kept here at the funeral director's 32 Wembdon Road branch. Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from oak veneer. Viewing of the deceased person for the family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director on unattended funerals only.
